MDVL 2000 Voices of the Middle Ages

MDVL 2000 is an interdisciplinary course designed to let voices from the past speak to us. Readings include *Hrafnkel's saga*, the *Song of Roland*, and the *Poem of the Cid*. Collectively these texts speak to us about **relationships** such as those between people of different religions and between spouses, as well as between lords and their men; about **values** such as loyalty, honor, heroism, and faith; and about **aspects of culture** that we take for granted today, such as medicine, education, easy means of communication, and travel. The course aims to teach students to read, hear, and respond to medieval voices.
